Job Description**

Our Mission:

To enhance the quality of life for the residents of the Golf Maine Park District and to promote a strong sense of community by providing a broad, diverse and challenging set of cultural and recreational programs and clean, beautiful and safe parks.

Job Title: Water Spray Park Attendant
Classification: Part-Time/Seasonal Non-Exempt
Salary Range: \$9.25/hourly
Department: Recreation

SUMMARY:

The spray park attendant has a legal duty to protect the safety of the people in the assigned area. The spray park attendant is obligated to prevent potential accidents by enforcing rules and regulations in the aquatic setting and to react to emergencies that occur.

SUPERVISORY:

The spray park attendant reports directly to the Recreation Supervisor.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES:

Manages the operation of the Water Spray Park including the testing of the water daily and making sure the spray park is operational through the mechanics and operation system that run the park.

Essential Functions

- Must test water hourly to make sure that pH and Chlorine levels are within the recommended standards.
- Must make sure participants obey posted water spray park rules at all times.
- Must make sure all who enter the water spray park have paid to use the facility and are wearing appropriate swim attire.
- Will be trained on the mechanical system that operate the spray park and know how to troubleshoot if operating is halted in any way to get it running again.

MARGINAL FUNCTIONS:

- Provide information to guests regarding facility layout and amenities
- Report emergencies to Recreation Supervisor
- Supervise private rentals as assigned (birthday parties, summer camps)
- Take daily attendance as request by recreation supervisor
- Keep spray park play area clean of garbage and debris

ENVIRONMENTAL/PHYSICAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- Must be able to sit outside for long periods of time in hot weather
- May be able to work in rain and rush to clear spray park if lightning is present
- Must be comfortable doing water testing with chlorine or muriatic acid being present in the water
- Ability to lift 50lbs.
- Ability to bend, squat, kneel, reach, stretch, climb without and difficulty.
- Exposure to chemicals, fumes, dirt, acids, odors, waste and dust
- Uniformed position

SAFETY RESPONSIBILITIES/RISK MANAGEMENT:

- Report all safety concerns or emergencies to the recreation supervisor
- Fill out accident or incident reports as they occur
- Keep first aid kits readily available

HOURS:

- Weekdays 1pm-7pm and Weekends 12pm-7pm
- Occasionally earlier mornings depending on rentals

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, TRAINING:

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- Demonstrated skills to work independently
- Ability to communicate effectively with the public, guests and staff members
- Must have emotional stability and the stability to make sound decisions to conform to facility responsibilities when dealing with adverse situations
- Must be firm, fair and consistent and courteous in order to gain the respect and cooperation of the public.
